

TAANA Mentor Program

Developing a relationship with a mentor can be of great value as one transition into the practice of law, or into a new area of practice. The American Association of Nurse Attorneys Mentor Program connects volunteer mentors with nurse in law school and nurse attorneys who are entering the practice of law or a new specialty. Both parties must be current TAANA members.

About the Program

TAANA mentors and mentees determine the scope of their mentoring relationship, including the frequency and regularity of contacts, and whether their meetings are virtual (telephone or Skype) or face-to-face. Some things a mentor might do include:

- Discussing areas of practice and offer general career planning advice
- Provide an opportunity for mentee to shadow them in the office or in administrative or judicial proceedings
- Critique a mentee's resume and facilitate a mock employment interview
- Provide networking suggestions
